Friday Afternoon Club on the Mountain Returns to Glenwood Caverns Adventure Park
Glenwood Caverns Adventure Park is the place to be for Friday Afternoon Club on the Mountain, with free tram rides, live music and food and drink specials from 5 – 8:30 p.m. The summer series runs from June 16 through August 18.

GLENWOOD SPRINGS, Colo. (June 15, 2017) — Glenwood Caverns Adventure Park, which won Locals' Choice Awards for Best Place to View a Sunset, Top Local Attraction and Best Music Venue this year, is giving locals more chances to enjoy it all again this summer with its Friday Afternoon Club (FAC) on the Mountain. Featuring live music, and food and drink specials, from 5 – 8:30 p.m. on Fridays from June 16 through Aug. 18, the park's FAC also includes a free tram ride with a coupon that appears in the Post Independent on Fridays. The coupon is valid for free tram or bus rides for up to four people starting at 4 p.m.

This summer's FAC schedule is as follows.

Friday, June 16: Frank Martin

Frank Martin is one the valley's favorite songwriters, singers and multi-instrumentalist. His vocals rise to gospel heights, and his guitar and mandolin playing cross genres with fire and finesse.

Friday, June 23: The Logan Brothers

The Logan Brothers are a Glenwood Springs-based classic rock, folk rock, and modern rock cover band. Their characteristic sound comes from outstanding lead vocals, two-part harmony, guitar, melodic bass lines, drums and harmonica.

Friday, June 30: Charley Wagner

Charley Wagner is a singer and songwriter with a laid-back, folk-Americana sound. Originally from northern Minnesota, he is new to the Glenwood Springs area.

Friday, July 7: Painters Stage

The gypsy sound and reggae rhythm is the heartbeat of Painters Stage trio of Noemi, Kristof and Max Kosmowski. They have been playing together for more than 25 years with the same contagious pleasure and passion.

Friday, July 14: Chris Bank

Chris has been performing in the Valley for 25 years as vocalist, bassist, saxophonist, percussionist and guitarist. His musical styles span a variety of genres from pop and soul to R&B and jazz.

Known for their performance of classic rock and singer/songwriter tunes, Starcher Hutsen performs originals and covers noted artists such as James Taylor, Snow Patrol, Eagles, David Gray, Beatles, Damian Rice, Kenny Wayne Shepherd and more many more.

Friday, July 28: The Logan Brothers

Friday, August 4: Goodman Unplugged

Friday, August 11: Feeding Giants

Feeding Giants is an acoustic-based, multi-genre group with smooth sweet harmonies, melodies and a unique sound.

Friday, August 18: Cellar Door

Cellar Door plays a variety of acoustic covers ranging in genre from folk and pop rock to reggae, hip-hop, and instrumental fingerstyle/percussive guitar.

Glenwood Caverns Adventure Park is located on top of Iron Mountain in Glenwood Springs, Colorado. Guests can take in panoramic views of the Colorado River and Roaring Fork Valley during the 10-minute tram ride and from the viewing decks. It's a beautiful spot to kick back and relax with friends at the end of the work week.

Guests can also enjoy the park's rides and attractions during the FAC events. A Funday Pass, just \$38 with the free tram ride, includes both walking cave tours and unlimited access to all of the park's rides and most attractions. The outdoor rides are open until dusk; the Laser Tag arena and 4D Motion Theater are open until the park closes at 9 p.m.
