GLENWOOD CAVERNS ADVENTURE PARK OFFERS ENTERTAINMENT FOR EVERYONE

Adventure Tour — Less strenuous than the Wild Tour but more challenging than the Cave Tour, this 90-minute guided tour allows cavers to explore new areas of the cave, exploring rooms filled with incredible formations. Total time required is 2 ½ hours to allow time to gear up and gear down before and after the tour. This is a moderately strenuous activity that includes belly crawling and squeezing through tight spaces. Protective gear and coveralls are available for rent. Liability waiver required. Reservations required: 970-945-4228 or 800-530-1635, ext. 111.¹

Alpine Rush — The Alpine Rush zip line takes riders on a thrill ride 650 feet downhill, over the tree tops, at speeds up to 50 miles per hour. They enjoy beautiful views of the Roaring Fork Valley as they ride to the top, then hang on for an exhilarating ride. Liability waiver required.²

Bungee Trampoline — Jump, twist, and soar through the air on our Bungee Trampoline. Once guests are strapped snugly into the safety harness, they start to jump as on any trampoline. The bungee cords allow them to jump higher and higher, adding somersaults and back flips, then returning back to the trampoline with each bounce. Liability waiver required.³

Canyon Flyer — Hop on the Canyon Flyer — *the first alpine coaster in the United States* — with individual cars on tracks that race 3,400 feet through the trees and down the mountainside. The vehicles are designed to carry two visitors in comfort, but can be handled easily by one alone. The riders control their speeds, which gives them a unique hands-on experience. The ride is exciting and varied, with bumps and waves built into the track to add to the thrill. Unlike an alpine slide, the Canyon Flyer makes hairpin turns and can operate year-round due to its track system. Liability waiver required.⁴



Cave Tour — The Cave Tour, a 70-minute guided walking tour in Glenwood Caverns and Historic Fairy Caves that's recognized as one of the leading family cave tours in the country, is appropriate for all ages. The Cave Tour takes visitors down into the caverns on a safe, well-lit walkway with handrails. Visitors will be amazed by The Barn and King's Row, gigantic rooms deep within the earth with other-worldly cave formations such as soda straws, stalactites, stalagmites and cave bacon.

Caverns Express — All aboard! The Caverns Express will take riders on a scenic journey through Glenwood Caverns Adventure Park. This is a motorized train ride with varying routes, not on tracks. Suitable for all ages. Free!

Demon the Mechanical Bull — Named in honor of the Glenwood Springs High School mascot, Demon, the mechanical bull ride offers rides from mild to wild for an exciting taste of the old West. Liability waiver required.²

Discovery Rock — Discovery Rock is a children's fun learning area where kids can pan for gemstones in the running water of the sluice box mining stream and search for buried treasure in the sand pit fossil dig.

Doc's Rock — Reach new heights on the 32' climbing wall — named for local legend Doc Holliday — with five different routes of varying difficulty, auto belay and a textured surface with fossils for the look and feel of real rock. Liability waiver required.³

Fort WhereAmI Maze — *New in 2008!* Ready, set, go! Kids will love finding their way through the labyrinth of twists and turns in this fort-style maze. They'll race against the clock and each other for fun and prizes.

Horseback Riding — Experienced guides lead half-hour trail rides on gentle, well-trained horses. Riders enjoy incredible views of Glenwood Canyon, Glenwood Springs and the Roaring Fork valley as they wind through the trees. Suitable for beginning riders. Liability waiver required. No reservations needed.⁵

Iron Mountain Saloon — Open in the summer months, the Saloon offers casual outdoor dining and snacks including pizza, sno-cones, ice cream, bratwursts, hot dogs, cold beer and more.

Iron Mountain Tramway — The Iron Mountain Tramway is a 4,300-foot-long tram ride originating at Iron Mountain Station on the floor of the Roaring Fork Valley, near the Colorado River in Glenwood Springs, Colo. Visitors of all ages will enjoy the ten-minute scenic ride inside six-person fully enclosed glass gondolas. The tram ride skims over the tops of the trees, with panoramic views in all directions. The gondolas are wheelchair accessible.

The Lookout Grille — Featuring some of the best panoramic views in Colorado, the Lookout Grille offers burgers, salads, sandwiches, a great kids' menu and more. The bar serves select wines, beers and mixed drinks.

Silk's Saloon Olde Tyme Photos — Take a step back in time with a visit to our Old Tyme Photography Studio, and leave with a memory to treasure for years to come. Costumes on hand to fit all shapes and sizes, from newborns on up, plus props and backdrops to create the perfect souvenir.

Swing Shot — For the truly adventurous, the Swing Shot launches riders out over Glenwood Canyon, 1,300 feet above the Colorado River! Both the ride and the views of the Canyon are breathtaking as riders soar through the air. The Swing Shot accommodates up to four riders at a time, so friends can share the adrenaline rush. Liability waiver required.²

Visitor's Center — Everyone can enjoy the 9,400-square-foot Visitor's Center that holds Adventure Park Gifts and the Lookout Grille. There are also banquet facilities for special events, weddings, class reunions, professional associations, and private parties. The Visitor's Center has 4,000 square feet of outside decks where visitors can view the scenery, take photographs, enjoy the sunset — voted Local's Choice for Best Sunset — and breathe in the clear Rocky Mountain air.

Wild Tour — The Wild Tour, a three-hour guided tour, gives visitors the opportunity to explore the rarely visited areas of Glenwood Caverns. Experienced cavers outfit each participant with a lighted helmet and all the necessary equipment. Wild Tour participants visit areas preserved in their natural state deep within the cave. This is an exciting on-your-belly crawling and walking experience that allows visitors to see awesome cave formations few people have ever seen. Liability waiver required. Wild West Adventure Wagon — Climb aboard our new Wild West Adventure Wagon and travel back in time to the days when cowboys and Conestoga wagons roamed the mountains. Riders feel the wagon bouncing on the bumpy trail and the wind rushing by as the narrator describes the journey. This simulated wagon experience lasts about five minutes and is suitable for all ages.

1) Ages 10 – 17 can participate if accompanied by an adult 18 or older. 2) Riders must be at least 52" to ride the Alpine Rush, and at least 48" tall to ride the Swing Shot and mechanical bull. 3) You must weigh at least 40 pounds to use the Bungee Trampoline and Doc's Rock. 4) Riders must be at least 54" tall and 3 years old to ride the Canyon Flyer alone. Riders less than 54" tall, but 3 years or older, can ride in the same car with an adult, free of charge. 5) Must be at least six years of age to participate. Closed-toe shoes required. 6) Ages 13 – 17 can participate if accompanied by an adult 18 or older.
